SI. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 03 (one sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 12. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Further, increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.
2	The school is not running bal-vatika. Thus, it is required to submit an undertaking on its letterhead that it will run the bal-vatika in the upcoming session within 03 months in the compliance.
3	The boundary wall is damaged / have gaps & the height of wall is 5 ft at some places. Further, some construction debris seen in the school premises. Thus, the school is required to repair the said parts of boundary, ensure that height of boundary wall should be minimum 6 ft on all sides as well as remove the construction material from the premises and ensure that school should submit the video link covering entire boundary wall from all sides in continuity along with aerial view in the compliance within 03 months.
4	The school has constructed a ramp to access the upper floors, but it is very steep and does not seem to be navigable by a wheelchair-bound student/staff. It is overlaid over a stair case. Thus, the school is required to dismantle the same and construct ramp/ lift to access upper floors with proper incline and safety features as per the provisions

	laid down in RPWD Act and Board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
5	The school has CwSN toilets only on ground and first floor. Further, entrance of said toilets school constructed ramp, however they are very steep and not easily accessible by the wheelchair bound students. Thus, the school is required to construct CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) with suitable entrance as per norms of RPwD Act and board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.
6	The school is required to work on the cleanliness of washrooms with running water supply to ensure better hygienic conditions within 03 months and submit the compliance.
7	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Vijayawada within 03 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/-every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the

- Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
- 8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
- 9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
